NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans 7 Years and Older (for Dogs and Bitches)

Chapter 11, Section 8, neutered dogs & spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - (May be neutered) For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a **Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.**

Brood Bitch Class - (may be spayed) Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace - (Two Dogs of the same variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) - The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Multiple Dog Entry Classes are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Generations - For three dogs, regardless of sex, of three successive generations (grandparent, parent, offspring). Entry is made for each dog (three separate entry forms) and there can be no substitutions of dogs. Only one \$21 entry fee is required for the unit of three dogs. At least one of the three dogs in the unit must be entered in a regular conformation class. Individual dogs may be entered in only one Generations Class unit. Each dog has a separate handler. Champions of Record and altered dogs may be entered.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: for boys & girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: for boys & girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: for boys & girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: for boys & girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class: for boys & girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class: for boys & girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

Sweepstakes

Distribution of Sweepstakes Prize Money

30% of total entry fees will be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 70% (for each Sweepstakes: Puppy, Veteran & Working) will be awarded as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes: 10% of total Sweepstakes entry

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes: 5% of total Sweepstakes entry

Placements receive percentages of the entry fees of the class entered:

First Place - 17.5% • Second Place - 15% • Third Place - 12.5% • Fourth Place - 10%

Indicate the Sweepstakes Class with the age division (if applicable) in the space provided for Additional Class. Champions of Record are eligible to compete.

Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Malinois who are 6 months but less than 18 months old on the day of the Sweepstakes. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All first place puppies compete for Best Puppy in Sweepstakes. All puppies of the opposite sex to Best Puppy will continue to compete for Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

The Following Classifications are for Dogs & Bitches

Puppy, 6 mos & under 9 mos
Puppy, 9 mos & under 12 mos
12 mos & under 18 mos

Veteran Sweepstakes

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Malinois who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants may be spayed or neutered.

The Following Classifications are for Dogs & Bitches

7 yrs & under 9 yrs • 9 yrs & under 11 yrs • 11 yrs & under 13 yrs • 13 yrs & over

Working Sweepstakes

The Working Sweepstakes Classes honor those dogs that compete in performance events. Dogs eligible to compete in these classes are any Belgian Malinois that has earned a performance title that meets the requirements for the ABMC Register of Merit (ROM). Entry in a Regular Class is not required. The Sweepstakes will be divided by Sex. Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to compete. A copy of at least one qualifying title certificate must accompany the entry form for each dog. If there is no copy of a performance certificate accompanying the entry, the dog will not be entered in the Working Sweepstakes class. Winners from the bitch and the dog classes will compete for Best in Working Sweepstakes with the Opposite Sex Winner being awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Working Sweepstakes.

Membership in the ABMC is not required. However, the dog being entered must be a Belgian Malinois.

A handler can enter a dog for the Most Versatile Award by filling out the MVBMA form available in the premium list or online at www.abmcspecialty.com. The form can then be mailed to the address listed on the form or turned in at least 1 hour prior to handler's 1st event at the specialty. The MVBMA committee chairperson will track the results based on the Show/Trial Secretary results. Handlers are encouraged to report wins and/or qualifying scores to chairperson. Points for each dog entered will be posted daily.

The winner will be announced at the After Party on Sunday night. The winner of the award need not be present to win. If the winner is not present, awards will be mailed.

Qualifications for Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award:

Dogs must participate and earn points in at least four of the following six venues:

- Agility (Standard and JWW Regular or Preferred classes in Novice, Open or Excellent)
- Conformation (Regular and Sweepstakes)
- Obedience (Regular, Graduate Novice or Open, and Versatility classes only)
- Rally (Regular classes only)
- Herding
- Tracking

A dog may be entered in more than four venues. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the points earned for that venue. Example: Dog A wins the Excellent A Regular Standard Agility class (5 points) and Double Q's in Regular Standard and Regular JWW (7points). Dog A will be awarded 7 points not 12.

The dog with the highest combined total score for all venues will be awarded Most Versatile Belgian Malinois. In the event of a tie see "Tie Breaking Criteria" at the end of the points list.

Prizes:

Most Versatile Malinois will receive a rosette and prize with a value matching that of Best Of Breed.

Reserve Most Versatile Malinois will receive a rosette and prize with a value matching that of Best Of Opposite Sex.

All dogs that qualify in at least four venues will receive a rosette and a certificate honoring their achievement.

Tie Breaking Criteria:

In the event of a tie, the winner will be the dog participating and earning points in the most number of venues. For example, in a tie, a dog that had earned points in all five venues would win over a dog that had earned points in only three venues. If a tie still exists, all point values earned in each venue would be combined and totaled for each dog with the highest total score being the winning dog. For example, a dog that had earned a High in Trial in Obedience by winning the Novice B class would count 7 points for High in Trial, plus 3 points for winning Novice B, plus 2 points for qualifying in Novice B. In the event the dogs were still tied after this tally, ABMC would recognize that an absolute tie occurred and dual awards would be given.
