ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry fees: (including AKC recording fee of \$3.00 for Each Entry)

\$50 per entry on sheep, \$40 per entry on ducks, all classes

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to ABMC.

One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday, March 21, 2012** after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

A dog may be entered in both a Trial class and a Test class for a given trial. However, either the Test or Trial entry should be designated the priority entry on the entry form, should the entry limits be reached. The other entries will be then taken as alternates. Bitches in season will run last in the Tests and in catalog order in the Trials.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds for pulled entries will be refunded as long as an alternate runs; if there are no alternates, no refunds will be given. Alternates will be refunded if those runs are not able to be entered in the trial. All alternates must report to the Trial Secretary before the start of the day's classes. If you do not, your spot may be given to an alternate in an earlier class.

Fax/Email entries: No faxed or emailed entries will be accepted

Entry Acknowledgements: To ensure the receipt of your entries, it is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. If you do not have email, send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope with your entry, which the Trial Secretary will return upon entry receipt. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

2. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
