Entries must be received by 6 pm CDT Wednesday March 21st, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient funds will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of the test. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be returned.

**Entry Limits/Preference:** Entry is limited to AKC registered dogs 6 months of age or older. Entries for dogs without a TD title must have included with the entry form a notice of certification from an AKC tracking judge (dated within one year of the test date) stating the dog is ready for such a test.

**The tracking test is limited to 8 TD tracks.**

Preference in the drawing will be given as follows:

- 1) Worker Draw
- 2) Belgian Malinois without a TD title
- 3) Belgian Malinois with a TD title
- 4) All other breeds without a TD title
- 5) All other breeds with a TD title

The draw will be conducted at the Test Secretary's address at 7pm CDT on March 21th, 2012. All entrants will be contacted via email or phone as soon as possible after the draw.

Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn shall fill the vacant position.

**Worker Draw:** The 1st draw will be made from entries submitted from people who worked at the 2010 and 2011 ABMC National Specialty Tracking Test. After that draw is made, all non chosen entries will be put in the draw for the other 7 slots. Dogs in the worker draw are not required to be Belgian Malinois. Eligible workers have been notified by Bonnie Craig.

Worker draw entries must have the words "**Worker Draw**" at the top of the tracking entry form.

**Entry Acknowledgements:** Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts via email. The Club nor the Test Secretary is responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If receipt of entry notification is desired, a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope must be included with the entry form. All entrants/alternates will be mailed a judging program after the draw.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Test Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Test Committee make it impossible to open or complete the test. Refunds will be made for any alternate who does not participate in the draw for tracks, and for any absent/withdrawn entrant whose track is filled by an alternate.

## Site Information

The tracking test is being held on the grounds of the Sullivan Missouri Industrial Park & Regional Airport. The area cover is ankle to knee-high grass field.

All dogs must be on leash at all times during the hours of this test.

This is an active airport and dogs and handlers must stay within the areas allowed by airport security. Failure to obey the boundary rules could result in loss of this test site for future tests and/or legal action.

**PLEASE clean up after yourselves and your dogs!**

The TD draw for tracks will begin at 8:30 am (local time) at the test site with the First Track to begin shortly after the draw.

Bitches in season may participate provided that the Test Secretary and Judges are notified that a bitch in season is present prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track shall be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

**HOSPITALITY:** There will be a light breakfast and coffee available at the test site.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
