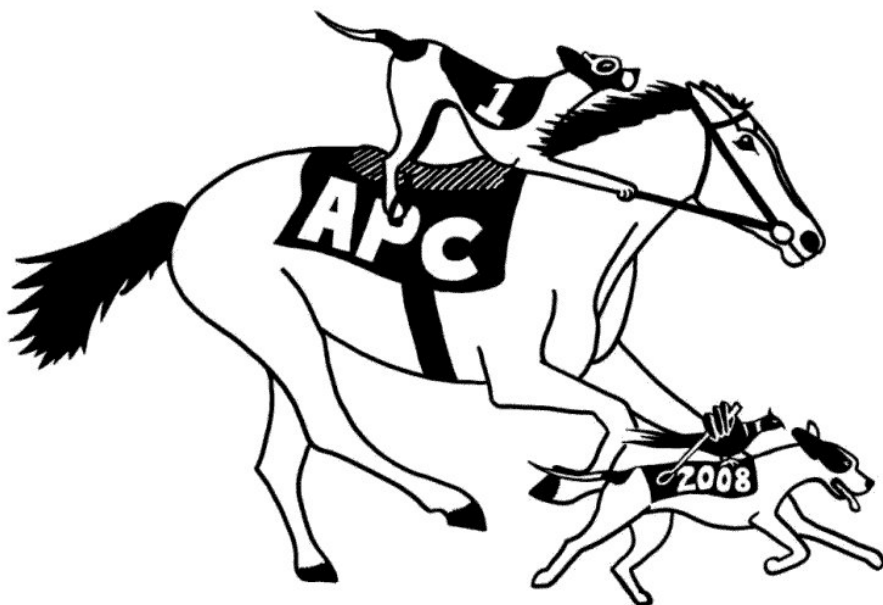

### Awards of Merit

The Judge may, at his discretion, select dogs and bitches to receive Judge's Select Rosettes.

### Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**Entry fees for these classes are \$31 for first entry or \$18 as an additional entry**

**Veterans Classes** – Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 to 9 years old; 9 to 11 years old; 11 years and over. **Veterans Note:** 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

**Field Trial Classes** - Class for dogs and class for bitches who have placed in a Regular Stake at an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial.

**Hunting Classes** - Class for dogs and class for bitches who have attained a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter Title at an AKC Hunting test.

**Stud Dog Class** – Class for Stud Dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Entry only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee is \$31.00 if the Stud Dog is not entered in another class, or \$18.00 as an additional class. Notation must be made on entry form.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

**Brace Class (two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.)** – Will require a fee of \$31.00 for the Brace Class as a first entry (Unit) and \$18.00 as an additional entry (Unit). The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. For online entries, this can be marked in the comments field.

**PARADES of champions and titleholders** – This non-competitive class is open to all Pointers who are 6 months of age or older and who have obtained their AKC Championship or Title prior to the entry closing date. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. Entry fee \$15.00. Please provide us with a short biography regarding your dog to be used as part of their introduction.

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## PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes is open to all Pointers who are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All Pointers entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class at the regular entry class fee. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form, under Additional Classes. AKC champions of record are **not eligible** to compete. **Entries must be exhibited by the owner or a member of the owner's immediate household. No one may exhibit in this class unless they satisfy the foregoing requirement. Please note: the above rule is applicable for any dog returning to the ring for Best of Sweeps.** The classes will be divided by Age and Sex, and winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. Entry fee is \$15.00

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## VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Pointers who are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Pointers entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a Regular Class. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form, under Additional Classes. The Classes will be divided by Age and Sex, and winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran's Sweepstakes. Entry fee is \$15.00

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## FUTURITY

### Futurity Rules:

The American Pointer Club National Show Futurity Stake is held in conjunction with the APC National Specialty Show, or between the dates of September 1st and November 30th each year. The Futurity Stake is open to all individuals with eligible puppies from nominated litters who have complied with the following rules:

**ELIGIBILITY** - Litters are eligible to be nominated for one Futurity Stake only for that year in which they have reached six (6) months of age as of September 1st, and will still be less than eighteen (18) months of

age as of that date. The year of the Futurity Stake will be indicated on the Nomination and Enrollment Forms furnished by the Futurity Chairperson. These Forms must be submitted, along with the appropriate fees in the form of a check or money order made payable to the American Pointer Club, to the Futurity Chair or before the dates specified. The postmark must conform to the dates specified. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN. *For example, to be eligible for nomination to the 2008 Futurity Stake, a litter must be whelped on or after March 2, 2007 and on or before March 1, 2008, so that the puppies will be at least six (6), but less than eighteen (18) months of age as of September 1, 2008.*

**NOMINATIONS** - To be eligible to nominate a bitch and her litter for the Futurity Stake, **at least one of the Breeders of Record of the litter must have been a member of the APC for the six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the nomination.** If there are additional Breeders of Record for the litter, and they were not APC members, the bitch and litter may still be nominated, but higher fees will be charged.

**A. BITCH NOMINATION**

1. The Bitch Nomination Form, accompanied by the appropriate fee, must be submitted **before the litter is whelped.**
2. If **ALL** the Breeders of Record were APC members for the six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the nomination, the Bitch Nomination Fee will be \$20.00. If one or more of the Breeders of Record were not APC members, the Bitch Nomination Fee will be \$40.00.

**B. LITTER NOMINATION**

1. A Litter Nomination Form, accompanied by the appropriate Litter Nomination Fee, must be submitted **within thirty (30) days after the birth of the litter.**
2. If **ALL** of the breeders of record were APC members for the six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the nomination, the Litter Nomination Fee will be \$10.00. If one or more of the Breeders of Record were not APC members, the Litter Nomination Fee will be Twenty Dollars \$20.00.

**C. LATE NOMINATION OF BITCH & LITTER**

1. A late nomination for a bitch and her litter will be accepted if submitted **within thirty (30) days after the birth of the litter.**
2. The combined Late Nomination Fee, which includes a late penalty fee, will be a total of \$60.00 if **ALL** of the Breeders of Record were APC members for the six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the nomination. If one or more of the breeders were not APC members, the combined Late Nomination Fee, including a late penalty fee, will be \$90.00.

**ENROLLMENTS** - To remain eligible for the Futurity Stake, puppies from nominated litters must be individually enrolled three (3) times by the dates specified. Late first and second enrollments of individual puppies will be accepted as noted below, but higher fees will be charged. No late final enrollments will be accepted. Please notify the Futurity Chairperson promptly of any changes in ownership and/or address for owners of enrolled puppies.

**A. FIRST ENROLLMENT & LATE FIRST ENROLLMENT**

The First enrollment fee of \$10 must accompany the First Enrollment Form and be submitted **before the puppy is three (3) months of age.** Late First Enrollments will be accepted if the First Enrollment Form is submitted **before the puppy is four (4) months of age.** The late penalty fee will be \$20.00. If one or more of the owners of the puppy is not an APC member, the fees increase to \$20.00, and \$30.00 for late enrollment.

**B. SECOND ENROLLMENT & LATE SECOND ENROLLMENT**

1. The Second Enrollment Fee of \$10 must accompany the second Enrollment Form and be submitted **before the puppy is six (6) months of age.** Late Second Enrollment will be accepted if the Second Enrollment Form is submitted **before the puppy is seven (7) months of age.** The late penalty fee will be \$20.00. If one or more of the owners of the puppy is not an APC member, the fees increase to \$20.00, and \$30.00 for late enrollment.

**C. FINAL ENROLLMENT**

1. The Final Enrollment Fee of \$10.00 must accompany the Final Enrollment Form. It must be submitted **at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the APC National Specialty Show and Futurity Stake** for which the puppy has been entered. The Final Enrollment Forms for individual puppies will be sent to the owners listed on the Second Enrollment Form.

2. **No late Final Enrollments will be accepted.**

**CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP** - When puppies from Futurity nominated litters are sold or transferred. Futurity eligibility is transferable to the new owners provided that Enrollment Fees are current prior to the change in ownership. Owners that acquire puppies from Futurity nominated litters are not required to be APC Members in order to maintain eligibility for the Futurity Stake.

**EVENT ENTRY AND ADDITIONAL RULES**

**A. ENTRIES**

1. A pointer that is entered in the Futurity Stake must also be entered in one of the regular or non regular conformation classes, or in an obedience class At the National Specialty Show with which the Futurity is

held. The same official show entry form must be used, stating both Futurity' and the appropriate class division (i.e., Futurity, Senior) in the space designated for additional classes.

2. The Entry closing date, by which time all entries must be received by the Show Secretary or Superintendent, and the amount of the Futurity Stake Entry fee, will be stated in the National Specialty Show Premium List.

**B. ADDITIONAL RULES**

1. Pointers that have completed their championships are allowed to compete in the Futurity Stake Event. Professional handlers are allowed to show in the Futurity Stake. There are no restrictions requiring that the handler must be an owner or breeder of the Pointer exhibited.

2. Non-APC members are allowed to exhibit in the Futurity Stake Event.

**CLASS DIVISIONS**

The Futurity Stake entrants will be judged in eight (8) Class Divisions ***divided by sex and by age as of September 1st in the year of the Futurity.*** The Class Divisions are:

Puppy - Whelped on or after December 2nd and through March 1st (6 months and under 9 months as of September 1st)

Junior - Whelped on or after September 2nd and through December 1st (9 months and under 12 months as of September 1st)

Intermediate - Whelped on or after June 2nd and through September 1st (12 months and under 15 months as of September 1st)

Senior - Whelped on or after March 2nd and through June 1st (15 months and under 18 months as of September 1st)

The eight (8) first place class winners will then compete for Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity.

**PRIZE MONEY**

A. POOLED PRIZE MONEY - All money collected from Nomination Fees, Enrollment Fees and Entry Fees shall be pooled. The APC will retain 25% of the total pooled funds to cover the APC's Futurity expenses. The balance will be divided as follows:

Best in Futurity 20%	Best of Opposite Sex 10%
Breeders of the Best in Futurity Winner 10%	Allocated to the classes 60%

B. CLASS PRIZE MONEY ALLOCATION - The Class prize money derived from the 60% of pooled prize money and allocated to the Classes will be distributed as follows:

1. The prize money awarded for each class is determined by dividing the allocated money by the total number of Futurity entries, and then multiplying that amount by the number of entries in the class division.
2. If only one is entered in the class, 1st place will receive 100% of the money.
3. If two are entered in the class, 1st place will receive 60% and 2nd place will receive 40% of the class money.
4. If three are entered in the class, 1st place will receive 50%, 2nd place will receive 30% and 3rd place will receive 20% of the class money.
5. If four or more are entered in the class, 1st place will receive 40%, 2nd place will receive 30%, 3rd place will receive 20% and fourth place will receive 10% of the class money.
6. Any Futurity money that was allocated for 1st through 4th place prizes in the class divisions, but could not be awarded due to absentees, will be retained by APC.

**MATURITY**

**Eligibility:**

1. The maturity stakes is open to all individuals who have complied with the following rules.
2. All Futurity eligible dogs/bitches (final enrollment paid) will be eligible for nomination to the following year's Maturity Stakes.
3. Eligible dogs/bitches may or may not have been shown in the previous year's Futurity Stakes.
4. These stakes are held at the national Specialty Show indicated on the Nomination blank.
5. Each dog/bitch entered in the maturity must also be entered in one of the regular classes of the National Specialty with which the maturity is held, EXCEPT the senior entry does not have to be entered in a regular or non-regular class.
6. Owners that acquire puppies from Futurity nominated litters are not required to APC Members in order to maintain eligibility for the Maturity Stake.

#### **Nomination and Payment of Fees:**

**A. Maturity entry where the dog is owned by all APC members - one time enrollment of \$20.**

**B. Where the dog is owned by any or all being Non APC members - one time enrollment of \$40**

made within 90 days after the National Specialty preceding the Maturity.

1. Futurity/Maturity Chairperson will furnish Nominations Forms.
2. Make Checks payable to the American Pointer Club, Inc. and mail with Nomination Form to the Futurity/Maturity Chairperson.

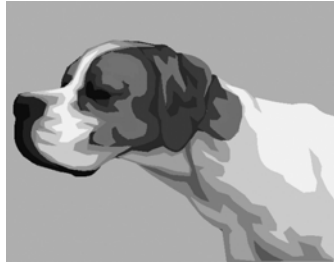
