IMPORTANT - Transfer of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed Competition (Ch. 11, Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. Transfers by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class MUST be made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Substitutions of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. Move up of dogs in Obedience/Rally Classes (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations) The request for a move up must be in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move ups for Obedience may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the show secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The show giving club, the show secretary, the hotel, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
