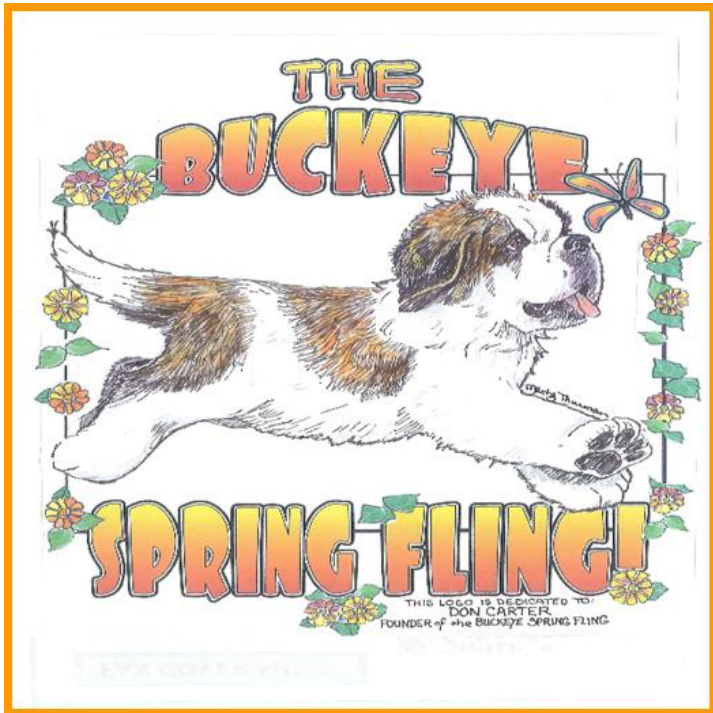

**Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)**

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

**Best Puppy Competition (Saturday)**

This Non-Regular Class shall be for first place winners of the Puppy Classes.

Dog and Bitches - Puppy 6 Months and Under 9 Months and Puppy 9 Months and Under 12 Months.

**Best Bred by Exhibitor Competition (Sunday)**

This Non-Regular Class shall be for competition between the first place winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Dog and Bitches.

**NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

**Veterans Class** – Class for dogs and class for bitches 6 years of age or older. **Veterans Note:** 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

**STUD DOG CLASS** – For Stud Dog and two or more of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualifications or excused under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog Class ONLY by paying The regular show fee of \$25.00. \$20.00 as an additional class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Show Chairman or Event Coordinator has authority to change rules for the safety and comfort of dogs and exhibitors.

No selling of dogs on show grounds.

Do not exercise dogs in roped off areas.

No dogs allowed in club house or restrooms.

We expect all exhibitors to display good sportsmanship.

The Show Committee, in accordance with AKC Rules and Regulations will deal with violations in this area.

**ALL TROPHIES NOT AWARDED WILL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE SHOW GIVING CLUB.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal value. Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None of the trophies will be mailed.

**Telephone Entries and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms** without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

**Fax Machine** entries for this show will be accepted up to closing time (central time zone). Both sides of entry form must be submitted. For Mastercard/Visa card holders ONLY. A \$4.00 charge will be added to each entry. Be sure to include the cardholders name, address, card number, expiration date & signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number: (888) 685-8989. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible FAX entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4).

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

An AKC Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the event service fee will be collected on additional entries as well. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the show secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

**The show giving club, the Show secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.**
