The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans 6 years and Under 8 Years Old

Veterans 8 years and Older

Veterans Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. They also may be considered for Awards of Merit. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

* At the discretion of the judge, one (1) Award of Merit may be awarded for every ten (10) entrants in the Best of Breed competition, with a maximum of seven (7) Awards of Merit. The Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Winners Dog, and Winners Bitch are not eligible for the Award of Merit. The winners of the Veterans classes are eligible for the Award of Merit.

This new rule effective next year is included at the request of the AKC as a courtesy to exhibitors.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS
Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

Classes

Novice Junior Class – This class is for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - This class is for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class – This class is for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class – This class is for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class - This class is for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class – This class is for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS
GENERAL

- The show site will be available to exhibitors at Noon, Saturday, October 17, 2009.
- Show hours are Sunday, October 18, 2009 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Security will be on the grounds 24 hours a day.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, free of any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Dog owners are responsible for clean-up.
- Clean up after your dog every time. Bags, scoops, and trash bins are placed strategically to be handily available.
- Dogs must be exercised in approved areas only. Signs are posted to direct you to exercise areas. No dogs are allowed to relieve themselves in the gardens or pool areas.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when exercising.
- Dogs must be crated when left alone in hotel rooms.
- The Great Dane Club of North Central Florida, the Great Dane Club of America, and the Southeast Division hosting clubs will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the show buildings or on the grounds at the Chattanooga Choo Choo.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during the Great Dane Club of North Central Florida Independent Specialty. No strollers are allowed.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building.
- Exhibitors are expected to comply with all Club rules as laid out and enforced by the Southeast Division.
- Exhibitors are admonished to familiarize themselves with the Agreement of the American Kennel Club referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Premium List.

Notice to Exhibitors

If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added.

An AKC Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the event service fee will be collected on additional entries as well. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). For All Rally entries, an AKC Recording fee of \$3.00 will be required (Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH ECHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund of duplicate entries.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by fax or e-mail prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

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3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
