Pre-Novice Class. The Pre-Novice Class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice Class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. However, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first four exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the same Group Exercise.

Graduate Novice Class. The Graduate Novice Class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. **However, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first five exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the same Long Down Group Exercise.** If eligible as defined in these *Regulations*, dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be

entered in any other obedience classes.

Veterans Class. The Veterans Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 6 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

Brace Class. The Brace Class will be for two dogs of the same breed that are eligible under these *Regulations* and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled (**the coupling device will not be less than 6 inches in overall length**). **Whichever method is used will be continued throughout all exercises.** A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered.

AKC Approved Evaluator: Ms. Gail Hawksworth

The CGC Test is a certification program that tests dogs in simulated everyday situations in a relaxed non-competitive atmosphere. The CGC Program rewards dogs that have the training and demeanor to be reliable family members as well as community members in good standing.

Rosettes provided for all CGC qualifiers.

Some of the Do's and Don'ts for taking this test:

- Do** make sure your dog is freshly groomed, nails short, ears and teeth clean.
- Do** bring a buckle or regular slip collar (no head or prong collars or harnesses).
- Do** keep your leash loose on all walking exercises.
- Do** bring your own brush.

- Do not** have treats in your pocket during your testing period.
- Do not** utilize harsh corrections.
- Do not** allow your dog to relieve itself in the ring.
- *These things will cause an automatic dismissal.

REMEMBER: Happy faces with happy dogs make a great team!

Irish Wolfhound Foundation Health Testing Heart Testing

The IWF is sponsoring heart testing on Thursday and Friday, May 20 and 21, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Tests offered include EKGs (electrocardiograms), echocardiograms, (cardiac ultrasounds) and blood pressure screening. Dr. William D. Tyrrell, Jr. veterinary cardiologist, will perform the echocardiograms. Reservations are necessary; for details, please visit the website at www.iwca2010.com/health_clinics. Sign-up sheets will be available during show hours for remaining slots. Owners pay only \$75 per dog, with the rest of the cost being paid by the IWF. Dogs two years of age and older are eligible. EKGs and BPs are free for those dogs getting echoes. There is a nominal fee for EKG/BP other dogs.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!!

Shade and Water: Shade tents/ex-pens must be at least 20 feet back from the ring. Chairs will be allowed at ringside but no ex-pens or tents (exception will be the tent for judges ringside mentoring and show videographer with narrator).

Please Note: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations, including those required by their home jurisdiction.

Obedience/Rally: All classes will utilize ring gating.

Hotel Etiquette

Clean up after your dog!! No dogs in the lobby.

Your dogs must be controlled at all times. No flexi-leads are to be used in and around the hotel for the safety of your dogs and other hotel guests.

The Show Committee has designated the entire hotel grounds as the show site. An Event Committee hearing may be held for any hotel complaint including but not limited to failure to clean up after your dog and destruction of hotel property.

An AKC Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the event service fee will be collected on additional entries as well. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). For All Rally entries, an AKC Recording fee of \$3.00 will be required (Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the show secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The show giving club, the Show secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each day. Carefully check the block(s) for each show in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class on different days (e.g. Open Class on Day 1 and American Bred on Day 2) or, if you are entering an additional class on any of the days (e.g. Open Class on Day 1 and Open Class plus Junior Showmanship on Day 2).
