ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: HOTEL & DOG SHOW RULES

A "Rules For Guest Conduct Contract" will be given out at the Registration Desk of the Host Hotel. Anyone refusing to sign the contract will not be given a room under the umbrella of The Chow Chow Club, Inc.

All guests should make a thorough check of their rooms upon arrival and report any damage. --Plastic is required under all dog crates.

A maximum of 4 persons are permitted in each resort room.

All dogs must be in crates when there is not a responsible person present in the room.

Damages to the room are the responsibility of the occupant and must be settled with the hotel prior to departure, or future specialties may be denied.

Keep your rooms clean and orderly. Housekeeping is required to check your room to be cleaned no less than every other day- NO EXCEPTIONS.

Dogs must be on leash at all times or confined in their crates, except when being judged and groomed.

Dogs must be on a leash when walking in resort rooms, hallways or any public areas of the hotel. No dogs are allowed in or near any food service outlet. Dogs are not permitted poolside or in any public restrooms.

Exercise dogs ONLY in the designated areas. Please clean up after exercising your dogs; equipment will be available for your convenience. Waste must be deposited in poop buckets provided by the club. If the area you are in does not have a bucket, it is NOT an exercise area.

The Grooming Area is a privilege extended by the Chow Chow Club, Inc. and the Host Hotel, which, can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow the instructions and rules of the Show Committee.

Grooming allowed in designated areas only. A spacious grooming area will be provided. NO BATHING AND GROOMING OF DOGS ALLOWED IN HOTEL ROOMS, hallways or ballroom. If there is any grooming found by the Hotel Staff or Show Committee in these areas, you will be asked to leave. Exhibitors are responsible for damages and clean up of their grooming area daily. Clean up supplies will be available.

The Show Committee will lay out and govern the designated Grooming Area. Grooming space will be available on a first come, first served basis. No space may be roped off or held with empty crates. To assure room for all exhibitors, please conserve and share space. The Show Committee reserves the right to condense an exhibitor's grooming area. NO DOGS TO BE LEFT IN THE GROOMING ROOMS OVERNIGHT.

The Show Committee will govern the use of Private Exercise Pens. NO indoor exercise pens.

There will be NO security guard on duty. DO NOT leave valuables out in the grooming areas. The Chow Chow Club, Inc., and the Sheraton Westport Hotel Lakeside Chalet will not be responsible for anything stolen or damaged.

Disruptive guests (and/or their dogs) may be asked to leave. Dogs are not to create a nuisance by continually howling or barking

Any damage to the hotel facilities (including grounds, parking lots) is up for disciplinary action by The Chow Chow Club, Inc. Bench Show Committee and the American Kennel Club.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Class for Dogs and Bitches
Veteran (7 years of age and older)

Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Winners, if otherwise undefeated are eligible for Best of Breed competition

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered as the Stud Dog & spayed females may be entered as the Brood Bitch.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs with at least one or more common owner. The two dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. Dogs entered in each Brace Class Unit must each also be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class at this show. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. First Place only to be awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to First Place.

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS (NON-COMPETITIVE)

The Parade of Champions, Titleholders is open to all Chows with an official title from a registering body (AKC, UKC, Canadian, CH, CD, RA, etc.) your Chow does not have to be entered in any class at the show. Each dog will be presented with a Rosette. Entry fee for parade is 20.00. Form is at the back of Premium List.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Awards of Merit may be given at the Judges' discretion to no more than 10% of the total entries of dogs and bitches in the Best of Breed judging. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, & Best of Winners awards are made.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.



SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY APPLIES TO SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

After 33% of the entry fee (for each division) is retained by the Club to defray expenses, the remaining monies for each class will be divided as follows:

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes are open to all Chow Chows who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are eligible. Dogs shown in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes with the regular entry, fee and on the official entry form. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

Indicate the Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division.

TOP 20 COMPETITION

The Top 20 Competition is a showcase of the top Chows from the 2002 statistical year. (Breed Points calculated from November 1 through October 31) All qualified Chows will receive a personal invitation to participate. What a chance for comparison! The Top 20 competition offers the opportunity to compete on equal footing, where the dogs are judged on their conformity to the breed standard, not just by one outstanding virtue, and not by their popularity. Dogs will be judged simultaneously by three different judges: a breeder judge, an AKC multi-breed judge, and a professional handler. Each judge scores the dogs individually per set guidelines. This discourages fault judging and places emphasis on individual qualities and overall conformation. Winners will be announced at the awards banquet. *After 5 Attire is Requested.*

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

All Challenge Trophies are offered through the Chow Chow Club, Inc. for Competition at the Chow Chow Club, Inc. Specialty Shows only. For permanent possession, a Challenge Trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog/bitch. The Challenge Trophy will remain in the possession of the Chow Chow Club, Inc. until permanently retired.
