(same for Veteran Bitch Classes)

Hunting Dog/Bitch Classes - This class is open only to those dogs that have received a title in AKC hunt tests. Entries may be spayed or neutered.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for the Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

BEST VETERAN COMPETITION

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from Veteran class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for the Best Veteran Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Neutered and spayed dogs and bitches may compete. **NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.**

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee – this being the regular fee **\$30.00** or the additional class fee **\$20.00**, if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

Brace – (For two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) Both dogs must be entered in another class. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, “Brace No. 1,” “Brace No. 2” etc. The fee for this class is **\$20.00**.

Junior Showmanship

Novice Junior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.
