Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog
- In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

EXHIBITORS NOTE:

Best Puppy Dog Rough will be judged immediately after Winners Dog Rough by the dog judge. Best Puppy Bitch Rough will be judged immediately after Winners Bitch Rough by the bitch judge. The same procedure will be followed in Smooths. The "Best Puppy" will be judged immediately after Best of Variety (Rough) and before Best of Breed. Smooth dog judging will be held on Tuesday morning. Smooth bitch judging will be held on Wednesday morning. If Champions are entered in more than one class they may not be exhibited in Best of Variety if they are defeated in ANY Regular or Non-Regular Class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

FOR BOTH VARIETIES

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches eight (8) years & under eleven (11) years.

Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches eleven (11) years & over.

Chapter 11, Section 8, neutered dogs & spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

EXHIBITORS: BE SURE TO INDICATE AGE DIVISION ON VETERAN CLASS ENTRIES.

ONLY FIRST PLACE WILL BE OFFERED FOR VETERAN CLASSES.

Herding Titled Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches over nine (9) months of age that have acquired an AKC Herding Title of Herding Started or higher (Does NOT include Herding Instinct Tests).

Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may **not** compete in Herding Titled Classes. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches may **not** be exhibited in any Non-Regular Single Dog Class entries except Veteran Classes in an Independent Specialty.

Best of Variety Competition

BEST OF VARIETY ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE:

Entries for Best of Variety judging will be brought into the ring in groups of 20 in catalog order. Dogs will be first with bitches immediately following. **IF YOU HAVE MULTIPLE ENTRIES & WANT THEM IN DIFFERENT GROUPS, PLEASE NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT IN WRITING BEFORE ENTRIES CLOSE, WHETHER VIA US MAIL, FAX OR ONLINE, AND DOCUMENT IT FOR YOUR RECORDS** otherwise they will have succeeding numbers. No changes will be made after entries have closed.

Best of Breed Competition

There will be competition for the following:

VARIETIES COMBINED

Best of Breed • Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed

Best Puppy in Puppy Classes • Best of Opposite Sex to Best Puppy in Puppy Classes

Best Bred by Exhibitor • Best of Opposite Sex to Best Bred by Exhibitor

Best American-Bred (Rough Variety only)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

FOR BOTH VARIETIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace - (Two Dogs of the same variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Multiple Dog Entry Classes are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOTE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. *Junior Handler Identification Number may be obtained by calling the AKC Judges Department at (919) 233-9767*

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

The Collie obtaining the highest point total will win the award. In each event, the highest score that can be obtained towards this award is 100. The following scoring system will apply:

BREED:

- All Collies that are a conformation Champion or have at least 5 championship points will receive a minimum of 40 MVC points for entering and showing in a conformation class at the CCA National.
- Collies with less than 5 championship points will not automatically receive any MVC points for showing in a conformation class. Points will only be awarded for placing in a class and defeating competition.
- Since this is an individual award, Brace Class performances do not count. No points will be awarded to Collies entering a conformation class and not showing (i.e. marked absent).
- In the BOV class, points will be awarded as follows:

Making no cuts: 40 points • Making first cut: 50 points • Making second cut: 60 points

Making third cut: 70 points • Awards of Merit: 80 points • Reserve Winners: 75 points

Winners: 80 points • Best of Winners: 85 points • BOS to BOV: 90 points • Best of Variety: 100 points

- In all other conformation classes, points will be awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in that class as follows:

- No placement: 40 points for conformation Champions and Collies with 5 or more CH points
0 points for Collies with less than 5 CH points

- Placements: Two (2) MVC points are awarded for every dog defeated in the class up to a maximum total number of 70 MVC points.
