USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Boykin Spaniels (*may be judged on the table, ramp or the ground at the judge's discretion*), Clumber Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Basset Hounds *, Whippets (*May be judged on the table, ramp or the ground at the judge's discretion*), Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs*, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. (*By Board approved policy: Basset Hounds & Bulldogs are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging) Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund)

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: for boys & girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: for boys & girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: for boys & girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: for boys & girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class: for boys & girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class: for boys & girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Master Class: for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

*Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.
