ROUTES TO THE SHOW (FROM THE HOST HOTEL)

From 71st St go west and then turn south onto Highway 169. Merge onto the Creek Turnpike and continue onto I 44 Turner Turnpike. Take the OK 33 Exit 211 toward Kellyville. Go left on 33 and right on OK 66 to 17806 W Highway 66. The Creek Fairgrounds will be on your left.

All hotel and motel sites are considered a part of the show site. All AKC rules and regulations apply. Complaints lodged against exhibitor or exhibitors will be under the auspices of the DCA Show Event Committee. Exhibitors must maintain these facilities in a clean and orderly fashion. The Show Event Committee will take disciplinary action against an exhibitor for any infringement of AKC rules and regulations regarding show sites and sportsmanship.

All owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog(s) in the proper height class.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Dalmatians 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or that have obtained an PAL/ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

Regular classes

- 8 Inches For the regular class dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches For the regular class dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches For the regular class dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches For the regular class dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 24 Inches For the regular class dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
- 26 Inches Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion.

Preferred classes

- 4 Inches For the preferred class dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 8 Inches For the preferred class dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches For the preferred class dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches For the preferred class dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches For regular class dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles used will meet the current specifications as set forth in the AKC Agility Regulations.

PLEASE NOTE: Entry fees minus expenses for bitches entered in Agility that come in season after entries close shall be refunded. Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial.

RING DESCRIPTION: This is an indoor arena with packed dirt surface. Ring dimensions are 100 x 90 feet. Crating will be available adjacent to the arena.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Move-ups must be received in writing/email by the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm, Monday, April 30, 2012.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. **A warm-up area**, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
