AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Important Notices

SHOW SITE AVAILABILITY: The site will be available after 5 p.m. on Monday, April 29. There will be no saving of spaces. All crates must be removed by 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 4.

CRATING: There will be ample crating space at the Washington County Fair Park & Convention Center. Dogs may **NOT** be left in the crating area after posted show hours. Hours of access will be 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M Tuesday, April 30 thru Friday, May 3. Hours of access are 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on Saturday May 4. All crates must have an ID with cell phone number clearly marked. Owners/handlers will be responsible for their dogs and will be asked to relocate them if they cause a nuisance by barking or disturbing other exhibitors. Be advised there will be no fair park security in the crating area.

FOOD AND ENTERTAINMENT: Food will be available at Washington County Fair Park & Convention Center at breakfast and lunch for purchase. **Other than snacks, we ask that you do not bring food purchased elsewhere into Fair Park.**

DOG EXERCISE AREA: There are ample areas to exercise dogs at Washington County Fair Park & Convention Center. It is imperative to respect the landscaping and shrubbery. **Owners/handlers MUST clean up after their dogs. No exceptions. Please be respectful at your hotel/motel and pick up after your dogs at those locations as well!**

CANDID PHOTOGRAPHY: Owners, breeders, handlers, spectators, and club members are allowed to take photographs of their own dogs from hand held devices only. **Teddy Lei is the only person who has permission to take win photographs from the podium. All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Vizsla Club of America, Inc., or in the person to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club.**

All attendees agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Vizsla Club of America, the Central Wisconsin Vizsla Club, the Twin Cities Vizsla Club, and Washington County Fair Park & Conference Center for any acts of negligence committed by their employees or vendors, including but not limited to the serving of alcoholic beverages.

Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.
