**NO DOGS WILL PERMITTED IN EITHER BUILDING UNTIL ALL VEHICLES HAVE BEEN REMOVED**

**Friday All Buildings (Ziegler, Pavilion, Small Animal and Sheep and Swine) will be available to exhibitors at 8:00 am.**

**All buildings close at 10:00 P.M. Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday.**

**Buildings will be available from 6:00 A.M. Saturday, Sunday, Monday & Tuesday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best In Show judging on Tuesday, July 6, 2021.**

**• NOTE •**

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

**“Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm’s way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm’s way is considered mistreatment.”** No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

### **IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION**

An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. Communicable diseases can be extremely contagious and/or lead to severe illness and death. Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to communicable diseases. It is incumbent upon event attendees to follow CDC and AVMA guidelines to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.

### **COVID PROCEDURES**

- Rings may be inside and or outside
- Handheld dryers only allowed inside and no dryers in the ring areas. Forced dryers allowed outside and in open air grooming building
- Please wear a mask when in close contact with others and in any of the show areas.
- Maintain social distancing of six feet.
- Wash your hands frequently. There are numerous sanitizer stations set up throughout the show site, please make use of them.
- There is no ringside seating, however, exhibitors can bring their chairs but must maintain social distancing between each other and from the rings. Household units are free to sit together. No group gatherings or congregating in the show areas.
- When approaching the rings for showing, only the steward will have access to the ringside catalog and armbands. The steward will look it up for you if necessary. To facilitate this process, please know what armbands you need. Please maintain a reasonable distance from the table and the person in front of you when securing your arm band.
- Stewards and judges will wear masks and judges will have hand sanitizer available between each examination.
- Exhibits-will line up outside the ring maintaining social distancing and exhibits will be called into the ring as each judge deems appropriate. The judge will direct you as to how to prepare your dog for exam. Follow the judge's direction. When gaiting with other exhibits, maintain a distance between exhibits. After placements are made, please leave the ring and, if you are not going forward in the judging of that breed, please leave the area. The judge or steward will direct those who will remain as to where they are to wait for Best of Breed judging.
- The above rules are our attempt to have a fun event and still maintain a level of safety for all who attend. We will have committee members circulating to ensure that everyone understands the rules and to answer questions. We ask that you honor any request made of you.
- If you are not feeling well, please stay home and get yourself healthy.

**FROM NORTH & SOUTH**-Take Hwy. 45 to PV (Pleasant Valley Road). Exit East 1/8 mile. Fairgrounds are on the North side of the road. Enter Bob Fish Drive.

**FROM EAST & WEST**-Take Hwy. 60 to Hwy. 45. Go North on 45 for 2 miles. Exit PV (Pleasant Valley Road). Go East 1/8 mile to Bob Fish Drive. Follow signs for Parking or Unloading.

- Show site **OUTSIDE GROUNDS** will be available after 2:00 p.m. Thursday, July 1, 2021.
- The Sheep & Swine open grooming building will be available after **8:00 am on Friday**
- The Pavilion building will be available after **9:00 am on Friday or as soon as the rings are setup**
- The Ziegler building will be available after **10:00 a.m. on Friday**
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED IN BUILDINGS UNTIL RINGS ARE SETUP AND VEHICLES HAVE BEEN REMOVED.**
- **All Doors will be locked at 10:00 pm Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday.** The buildings will open at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday, Monday & Tuesday. Dogs maybe left in buildings overnight, there is security. All dogs must be removed from the Show Site Immediately following Best In Show Judging on Tuesday, July 6, 2021.
- **AED ON SITE:** Ziegler Building in Rotunda, Pavilion Building end of rotunda near bathroom Hallway.
- Exhibitors must pick up after their dogs at hotels and the Show Site. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action.
- There will be absolutely no parking permitted in the unloading zones.
- **ALL CRATES MUST BE STACKED.** NO floor pads or **BABY PLAYPENS** permitted in grooming area.
- No dogs will be admitted through the main lobby (rotunda) of the building (a Fair Park policy).
- Admission will be charged at the parking lot entrance: \$5/vehicle per day (except RV's).
- No private x-pens in the building.
- No Baby strollers in the building.
- All exhibitors are expected to clean up their own grooming areas.
- All crates in the main building must be stackable. **SOFT SIDED CRATES MAYBE USED AS TOP CRATES ONLY!!!**
- **NO PARKING PERMITTED IN ANY OF THE OUTBUILDINGS. THERE WILL BE LIMITED OUTDOOR ELECTRIC AVAILABLE IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.**
- **NO UNENTERED DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN SHOW BUILDINGS OR THE IMMEDIATE SHOW AREA. OBEDIENCE & RALLY WILL BE HELD IN THE NEWLY AIR CONDITIONED SMALL ANIMAL BARN.**

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
