Hotel Fees/Deposits

The room rate is \$89 per night plus tax for a total cost of \$97.90. Damage waiver forms will be provided for completion at check-in.

Guests have up until 72 hours prior to cancel their individual reservations. The room block is set up so that everyone calls and makes their own hotel reservation and deposit. The entire room block will be held until 9-15-2017 after which any rooms reserved in the block without a reservation, will be released back into inventory.

The guest agrees to take full financial liability for all damages by the pet including but not limited to: odor, damaging furniture or any part of the room, urination, etc. This includes other parts of the hotel where the dog may have to pass through to get to the rooms, i.e., the hallways and elevators. The room is to be inspected by a hotel associate and a designated member of the Show Committee before the deposit is credited or returned.

IF YOU ARE CAUGHT NOT FOLLOWING THIS RULE YOU WILL HAVE A BENCH SHOW HEARING AND FINES

Best of Breed Competition

NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Veterans 7 Years & Older

Each Veteran Class Winner is eligible for Best of Breed Competition, provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class. Chapter 11, Section 8, neutered dogs & spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

AWARD OF MERIT

This award is to recognize excellence beyond Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

All Saints eligible for the Best of Breed class, except those awarded Best-Of-Breed, Best-Of-Opposite-Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible to be given an "Award-Of-Merit" (AOM) subject to the following restrictions:

- The maximum number of AOM's that may be awarded shall be ten (10%) percent of the total number of entries in the Best of Breed class, INCLUDING Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, Veteran class winners, Working Dog winner, Working Bitch winner, and those dogs moved up to Breed per AKC rules. In calculating the maximum number of AOM's allowable under the 10% rule, any fractional number shall be rounded off to the next highest whole number. For example: with 67 Best of Breed Saints entered, plus WD, WB, Veteran Dog, Veteran Bitch, Working Dog and Working Bitch (total number of 73), ten percent is 7.3, thus rounding off the maximum number of AOM's that may be awarded is 8, the next highest number.
- The judge may withhold any or all of the AOM's for lack of merit.
- There shall be no limitation of the awarding of AOM's with respect to sex
- Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch are NOT eligible for AOM, however both Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are eligible for AOM.
- All AOM's receive the same recognition and awards.

- AOM's are chosen immediately following the Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. The dogs must remain in the ring to receive the awards.

BEST PUPPY IN SHOW COMPETITION

Best Puppy – First place winners in Puppy Classes, 6 mos. and under 9 mos. and 9 mos. and under 12 mos., both sexes will compete together and will be judged after Best of Breed.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW COMPETITION

Best in Bred by Exhibitor – First place winners in the Bred by Exhibitor Classes will be judged together, to be judged after Best in Puppy Classes which will be judged after Best of Breed.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Classes Divided by Age

- Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs**
- Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**
- Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs**
- Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs**
- Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**
- Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs**

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.

- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.
