**According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of AKC Obedience Regulations and Chapter 1, Section 22 of the Rally regulations, entries will be limited. Each judge will be limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time per day. Obedience Trials will be limited as follows: Thursday limited to 4 hours each trial. Rally Trials will be limited as follows: Thursday limited to 4 hours each trial. When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial's limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted.

*In Obedience & Rally Classes requiring jumps, entries MUST include the Dog's Jump Height

In classes with jumps, the judging order will be lowest to highest jump height (ascending)

Refund for bitches in season entered in Obedience or Rally, will be allowed. Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the event secretary is notified no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the club is required to refund the entry fee. The club will retain a \$4.00 processing fee for the cancellation of an entry.

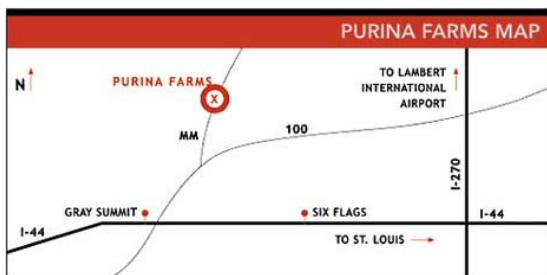

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries (Each Specialty)

Veterans Class: A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

Entries in the Veterans Class may be spayed or neutered.

Field Class: A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches who have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or who have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date.

Entries in the Field classes may NOT be spayed or neutered.

Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition provided they are undefeated in any other class.

Non-Regular Classes - Involving Multiple Dog Entries (WCA)

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. This being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the stud dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Classes - Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (A Unit) irrespective of sex, with one or more common owner. The Brace will be judged on consistency. Dogs entered in each Brace Class Unit must each also be entered in a Regular Class. Show Brace Class in "Additional Class" portion of the entry form. Please note the AKC registration number or registered name of the other dog making up the brace unit on each entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

Awards of Merit (Each Specialty)

The judge may, at his discretion, recall into the ring up to six dogs or bitches to receive a Judge's Award of Merit.

Best Bred by Exhibitor (WCA only)

Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Dog & Bitch Bred by Exhibitor classes. All dogs entered in the Bred-by Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-by-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-by-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-by-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-by- Exhibitor competition.

Best Veteran (WCA only)

Best Veteran will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes.

Sweepstakes (WCGSL)

Requirements & Classifications

Sweepstakes is open to all Weimaraners 6 months of age and under 24 months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at the Regular entry fee and on the same entry form at this Specialty show. Indicate your entry in Sweepstakes including age division in the box marked "Additional Classes."

DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES:

Veteran Sweepstakes (WCGSL)

Veteran Sweepstakes open to Weimaraners who on the day of the show will be at least 7 years of age. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in any other class. Entries will be made in the Veteran Sweepstakes by indicating VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes.

DIVISION OF VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES:

Thirty-five percent (35%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses.

The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

10% Best Veteran Dog in Sweepstakes, 10% Best Veteran Bitch in Sweepstakes

Remaining 45% will be awarded to the First Place winners of each class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Each Specialty)

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

Indicate your dog's Futurity Class on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes. Notice: all entries must comply with the rules governing the WCA's Show Futurity. Exhibitor is solely responsible for knowledge of and compliance with those rules.

Classification

Senior Dog/Bitch - Born on or after June 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015

Intermediate Dog/Bitch-Born on or after Oct. 1, 2015 through Jan. 31, 2016

Junior Dog/Bitch - Born on or after February 1, 2016 through May 31, 2016

The order of judging will be: Junior Dog, Intermediate Dog, Senior Dog, Best Dog in Futurity. Junior Bitch, Intermediate Bitch, Senior Bitch, Best Bitch in Futurity. After the judging of Best Bitch in Futurity, the Best Dog and Best Bitch will enter the ring together with no further judging to take place. Both Winners will share equally in the honors and awards.

PURINA FARMS GUEST RULES

Property Access and Building Hours

The Purina Event Center will be available to Exhibitors from 12 Noon, Tuesday, June 6, 2017 until 10pm; Wednesday, June 7 through Friday, June 9, 6am until 10pm; Saturday, June 10, 6am until 8pm.

No Dogs may be left overnight in the Event Center.

RVs may arrive after 9:00am on Tuesday, June 6, 2017. RVs must leave by Monday, June 12, 9:00am. See Page 18 for RV Reservations.

- The front Purina Farms entrance/exit gate is manned daily by a security guard from 8a.m. – 4p.m. to allow access to the property. Gates may be closed outside of these hours, but access to and from the property is still possible by pushing a call button at the gate or calling security at 636-221-1428. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave.
- Regular Purina Event Center building hours are 6a.m - 6p.m. unless otherwise posted.

Clean-up

- Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. This includes properly disposing of waste and using designated relief areas and the public x-pen area on the East side of the Gateway Hall for all elimination needs.
- Designated stations throughout the facility should be used appropriately (i.e. watering station should not be used for waste or other materials)

RV Lots

- There is a nightly charge for use of full-service RV spots. Reservations should be made through the organization hosting the event. No sharing of hook-ups with non-paying RVs.
- All RV overnight guests are asked to check-in upon their arrival with a member of the organization hosting the event.
- Show grounds open at noon or 3p.m. on the designated set-up day for the event depending on what is reflected in the rental contract. Any RVs arriving before that time will have to park in an open spot in the overflow RV lot or at the Outdoor Agility Field. Please note that quiet hours on the property are 11p.m. –6a.m. Exhibitors with RVs coming in or leaving during that time should be respectful of other campers and be as quiet/non-disruptive as possible.
- Spaces in the overflow RV lot (#11-44), near the Main Show Field, are free and first-come; first served. Each spot offers electric (30amp and 50amp) at no cost. Rentals in the overflow RV lot should be dropped in any open spot. The rental company is responsible for notifying the renter of the space #. Space #s 1-10 are reserved for events taking place in the main show field and Space #s 45-47 are reserved for earthdog activities taking place at the Go To Ground dens unless permission is given otherwise by Purina Farms management.
- Only cars (max of 2) affiliated with the RVs parked in the spots will be allowed to park in the same spot in the RV lot. Any cars not affiliated with the RVs in the spots will be asked to move or be towed at the owner's expense.
- In case of a medical emergency in the RV lot in the evening or after hours, guests needing medical attention should leave the lights on their RVs allowing the response team to easily identify the appropriate vehicle.
- Grilling is permitted in the RV lot, but guests should let the coals burn out overnight, bag them the next day and put them in a trash barrel. For safety reasons, no campfires are allowed on the property.
- In case of inclement weather, see the inclement weather procedures section of the rules.

Vehicles

- Guests may not bring or use motorized vehicles on the property unless a medical condition requires the use of one. Documentation must be presented upon request by Purina Farms staff. An organization can rent motorized vehicles for use to help shuttle their participants around the property
- Golf carts may not be parked on sidewalks.

Grooming

- 20 amps of electric service available per assigned space
- All grooming in The Great Hall must be on 4mil plastic that covers the floor.
- Please assess grooming tables to make sure they won't damage facility floors. Rubber caps for the tables are available if tables appear like they will damage the flooring.

All food and beverages

- Need to be purchased through the on-site food service and catering company.
- No outside food or beverage, or outside food service/catering company, is allowed on the Purina Farms property (unless organization receives written permission from Purina Farms management).
- Any violation will be reported to the AKC or the appropriate sanctioning entity of the event.

Crating

- Crating in The Great Hall is determined by the organization hosting the event. It will not be dictated or enforced by Purina Farms. All crates must be on a solid type of matting that won't allow liquids or other substances to seep through on to the floor

Security and Overnight Crating

- Dogs may only stay overnight in the facility if the organization has arranged for overnight security through Purina Farms. It is at the discretion of the organization hosting the event.
- Any dog staying overnight in the building must have a notecard on its crate clearly displaying a cell phone number of the owner and/handler in case of emergency. Guests may not be in the building after the building closes for the night at either 10p.m. or 11p.m. as posted.

Dogs

- No dogs are allowed, except for service dogs: in the Checkerboard Café, on the second floor of the Purina Event Center (unless given prior permission) and in any restroom or human bathing area.

- All dogs are required to be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged)
- No swimming (dogs and people) allowed in any ponds on the property
- No dogs should be left unattended in the off-leash exercise areas or the public outdoor x-pens around the property

Parking

- No parking is allowed in the following areas: Fire lanes, inside either Hall (No vehicles are allowed to drive inside either hall) or on the sidewalks leading into either Hall except where loading and unloading is designated. In addition, no driving is allowed on sidewalks.
- Driving or parking on any grass at Purina Farms is prohibited
- All guests must abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Purina Event Center

Supplies

- Duct tape may not be used in the building. Only painter’s tape and gaffer’s tape can be used on the floor and walls of the facility.

General

- No helium balloons in either Hall. Balloons can be used in the Founder’s Room for special events (with approval from the Director of Purina Farms). No glitter or confetti allowed in the facility.
- Alcohol may not be brought to the Purina Farms Visitor Center or the Purina Event Center. Any exceptions need to be preapproved by Purina Farms management. Purina Farms is a “family friendly” place and public intoxication is prohibited.
- No exercise pens allowed around the front and back of the Purina Event Center or the grassy area adjacent to the East side of the Gateway Hall. Overall, exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged. Any exercise pens on designated grassy areas should not have a flooring/covering to prevent damage to the grass.
- All veterinary exams, tests, and medical procedures must take place only in the Service Center.
- All guests and their dogs must remain on the part of the property owned by Purina Farms. Trespassing on Purina Animal Nutrition property is forbidden. Purina Farms and Purina Animal Nutrition are not affiliated. Property map showing divisions can be provided upon request.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times, when on the grounds (including the Purina Farms Visitor Center and especially on the balcony at the Purina Event Center).
- Guests accept personal liability with respect to any claim made in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dog/s or dogs in their possession.
- No selling of puppies or dogs on the premises.
- Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited in buildings.
- No hunting, tent camping or swimming.
- Weapons of any kind, illegal drugs and fireworks are not permitted on the premises.
- Purina Farms logs all lost and found items and stores them in a secure, locked area. Please email Purina Farms at purinafarms@purina.nestle.com or call 314-982-3232 to retrieve a lost item. Proper identification must be shown in order to claim an item

Special Notes: Purina Event Center staff reserves the right to refuse entry to any party/person or animal and retains the right to remove any person or persons and/or any animal from the premises in order to ensure the safety of any and all visitors, including dogs and cats. Guests indemnify Purina, the affiliated person/s or businesses conducting the event, against any and all claims of arising that may be leveled against them, jointly or severally, in respect to any damage, injury or loss to persons, pets and/or property.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event a severe weather or tornado warning is issued for the immediate area, Site Security will notify the Purina Farms management team. The team will notify guests of an impending weather event via the property-wide public address system and via the storm siren and announcements. Guests will be asked to seek cover in designated areas marked as severe weather shelter areas inside the Purina Farms facilities (those in the outdoor event areas should seek cover in one of the indoor facilities on the property). Areas at the Purina Event Center include the Gateway Hall, restrooms, center hallway, South stairwell and the Great Hall if necessary. After the weather event ends, Purina Farms management teams will announce all clear.

- If weather is extreme after-hours, then security will unlock the Purina Event Center to allow overnight guests to come into the building with dogs at any time. The service center is also open 24/7 for campers to seek shelter.
- Should the weather look threatening, Purina Farms Security will go around the RV lot to notify overnight guests to seek shelter. Security will also visit the outdoor event areas around the property to let guests know there is threat.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
