Pooper-scoopers will be placed around the show grounds for your convenience. If your dog soils in the show ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while you do the clean-up. A pooper-scooper will be placed outside each ring.

Responsible dog owners realize clean-up after their dogs is their responsibility!

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

*NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.*

**\*Veteran Dogs, 6 years & under 8 years**

**\*Veteran Bitches, 6 years & under 8 years**

**\*Veteran Dogs, 8 years & under 10 years**

**\*Veteran Bitches, 8 years & under 10 years**

**\*Veteran Dogs, 10 years & over**

**\*Veteran Bitches, 10 years & over**

*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."*

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

*Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.*

**\*Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed. Entry Fee: Stud Dog Only - \$29.00. Stud Dog as an additional class \$21.00.

**\*Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

**Brace Class** - For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than one handler. Both dogs must be entered in another class at this specialty show. The entry fee is \$21.00 as an additional entry for the Brace as a UNIT. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

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## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

### **Classes Divided by Age**

**Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**

**Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs**

**Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**

**Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.**

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

# SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Bullmastiffs who on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Classes will be divided by age and sex. All entries in the sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entry fee is \$18.00 for each dog and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" **and the age division** in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family or by an amateur handler with exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense, and all prize money is the property of the owner.

## SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

*The winner of each age group will compete for BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES.*

Champions of Record are eligible for the Veteran Sweepstakes. Classes will be divided by age and sex. Each dog or bitch NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at the show. Entry fee is \$18.00 for each dog and entries shall be made on a regular entry form. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" **and the age division** in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.
